Sunday is the day for worship in the Chaplaincy. You will find a warm welcome at both churches.

San Pedro: Service with hymns, sermon and communion, celebrated by an Anglican priest (our Chaplain who is based at Estepona).

Sotogrande: midday services are shared between the Anglicans (2nd, 4th and 5th Sundays in the month) and the Methodists on the 1st and 3rd Sundays. Many of the congregation come to both Anglican and Methodist services. On the Anglican

Sundays, there is usually a selection of hymns, readings, sermons and communion celebrated by the Chaplain.

All Chaplaincy services include music, hymns, songs, old and new, with talented musicians and choirs accompanying the worship at each church.

We welcome all who are baptised, or who would normally take communion in their own church to take communion with us.

We also organise additional services during the major festivals in different locations on the coast.

Each church offers a small Sunday school at the same time as the worship, where even the youngest family members can be included in some fun activities. All our teachers have completed proper safeguarding checks.

LOVE

The churches have a ministry of love to the Costa del Sol, to the world, and especially to our frailer members. There is a pastoral care team which visits the housebound and the Chaplain takes home communion to those who would like it.

As well as refreshments after our services, we also hold regular social events, which include 'coffee' mornings (in Sabinillas), and a varied programme of social activities including beach meals, quizzes, prayer walks, Christmas fair and lots more.

We visit a local home for the elderly for English communion once per month, and support five local charities, including one NGO that gives support to refugees. 10% of our income goes to these charities.  costachurch.com
