Dust + Glory is the Church of England's Lent theme for 2023. This Lent we are invited to explore how we can live well with the mess of everyday life.

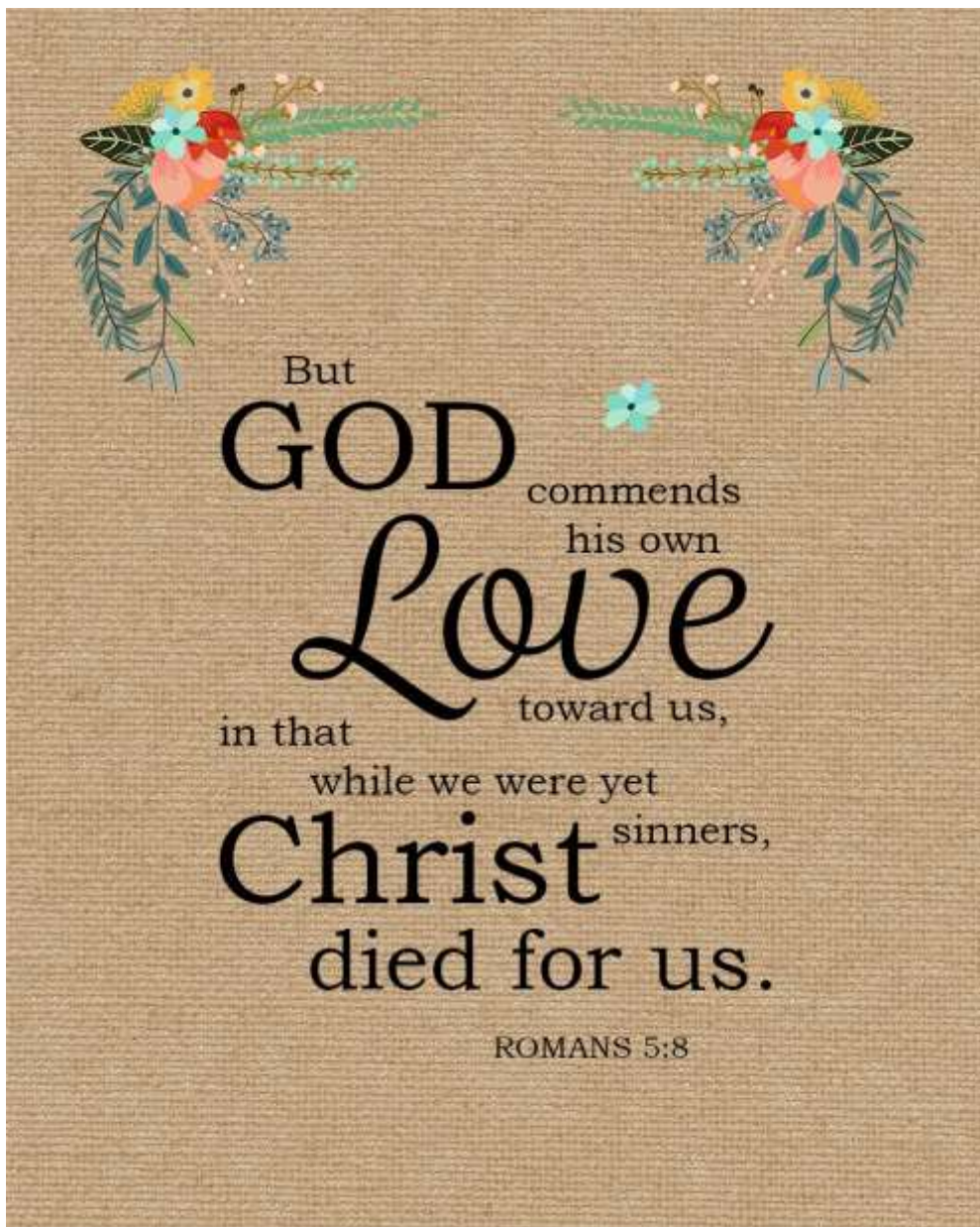
