


## MAUNDY THURSDAY 6th APRIL

Maundy Thursday (April 6) is the beginning of what is known as the sacred Triduum – the three intense days for Christians in which we celebrate our Lord's Paschal Mystery of his suffering, death and resurrection. The special liturgies for these three days actually are one continuous celebration of this mystery. However circumstances at this time do not allow us to have easy access to the church buildings during this period, and so our remembrance of the Lord's Passion comes on Palm Sunday, and we remember the Institution of the Eucharist, including the symbolic action of the washing of feet, in a celebration at the **Chaplaincy House** on Maundy Thursday at **12h30** which will be followed by a light 'bring and share' lunch.

Please let Alex know if you are intending to be present. The celebration of the Lord's resurrection will, of course, be on Easter Day (April 9), and will include the renewal of our baptism vows from the liturgy of Holy Saturday.
