The lunch will be at 'La Tradicional' which is a short walk from the San Pedro Church. The lunch will be three courses plus two small drinks for **15 Euros!**

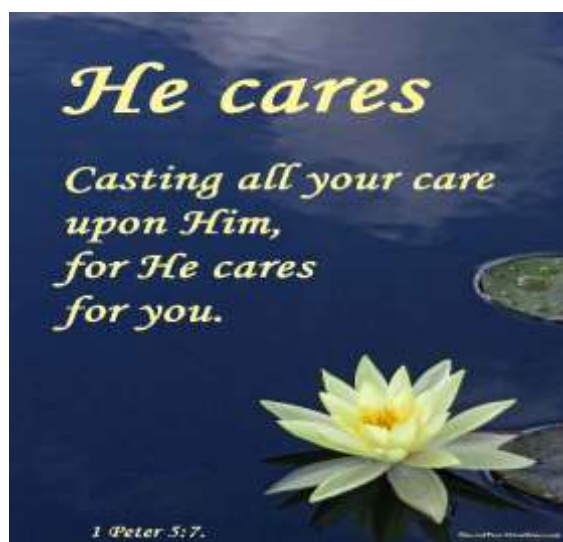
