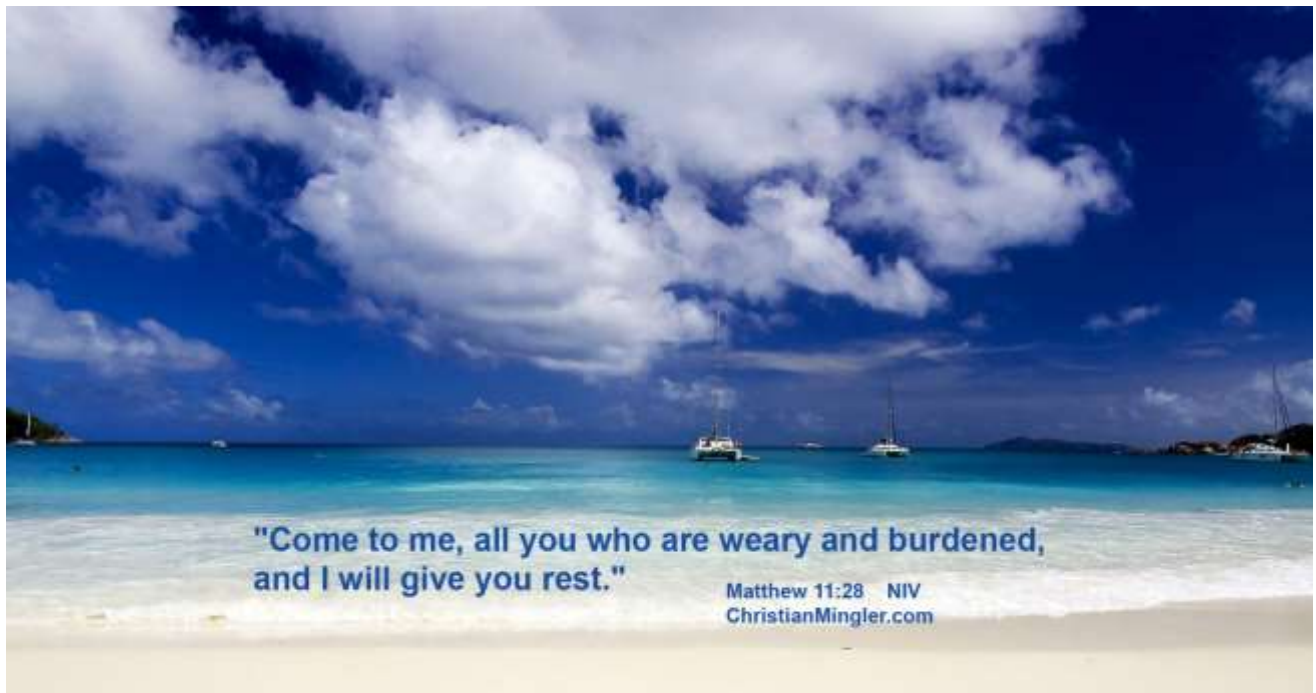

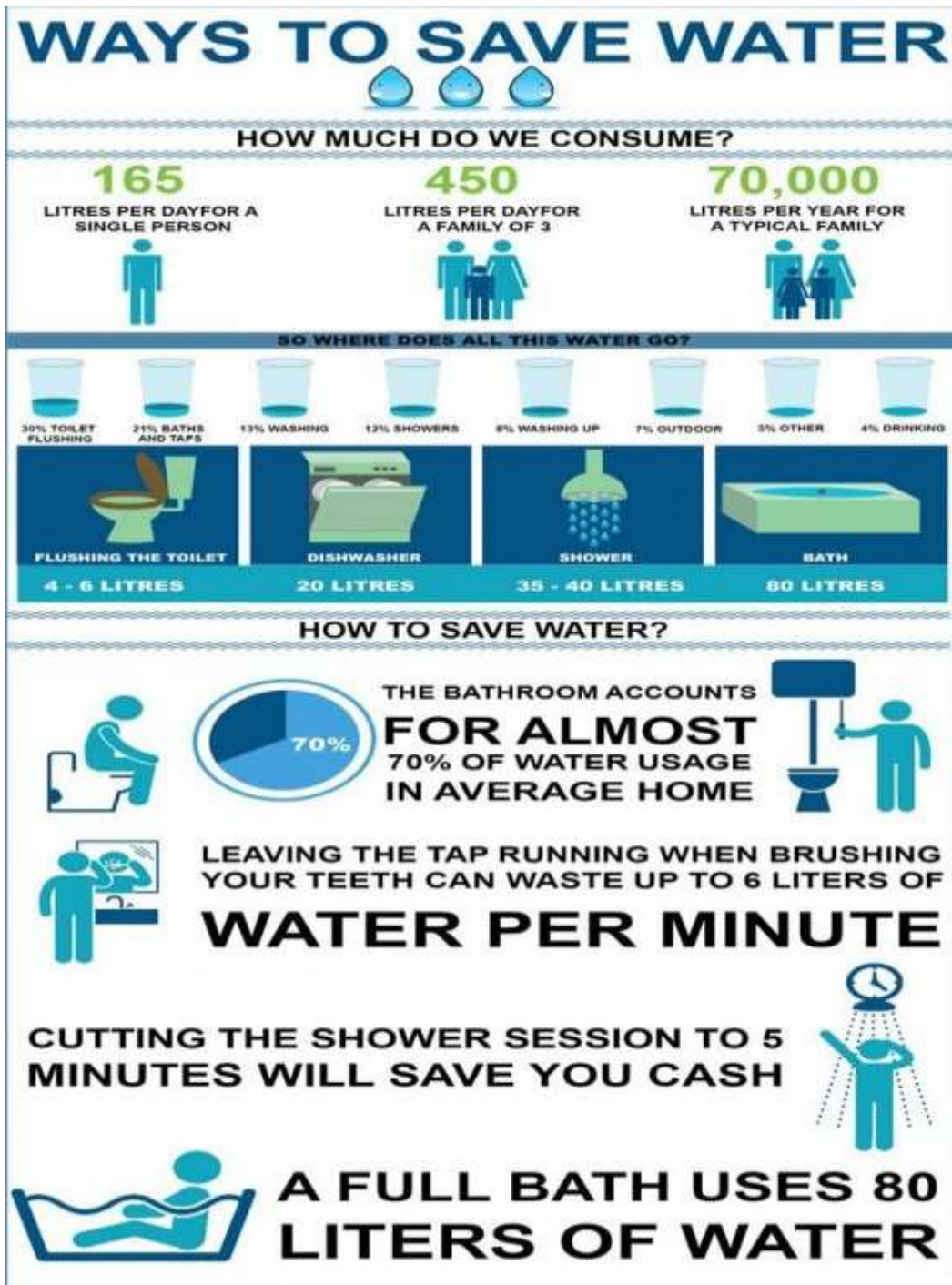
PRAYER GROUP
