

The Sotogrande event will include the Camerata choir as part of the service.



December is turning out to be a busy month and it does not look like we will be able to fit in a Messy Church before Christmas so the next one is likely to be the second week in January - watch out for notices!








RESIGNATION OF SOTOGRANDE CHURCH WARDEN


