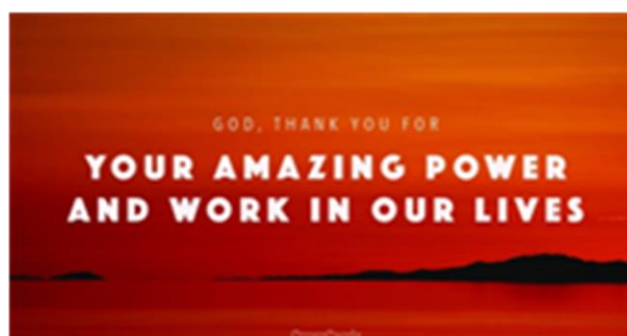
PRAYER GROUP
