### Archdeaconry of Gibraltar Synod 30 Jan – 2 Feb in Calpe

Patricia, Lorenzo and Tony (our three chaplaincy representatives) attended the yearly Archdeaconry Synod which took place in Calpe on the theme of "Walking together in faith" from Tuesday 30 January until Friday 2 February. The synod is a yearly opportunity for the chaplaincies of the archdeaconry (Spain, Portugal, Andorra, Gibraltar and Morocco) to meet and to discuss the life and mission of our church. It was a particularly special meeting this year as our assistant (suffragan) bishop, David Hamid, was retiring after over twenty years of service in the post. The atmosphere was friendly and the meeting enabled an exchange of both the challenges and the opportunities facing our chaplaincies to be shared in a spirit of trust and faithful prayer. Through a series of inputs from speakers on matters relating to the life and mission of the archdeaconry, guided prayer sessions, reports from chaplaincies, small group work and liturgies, the synod was led to encounter the Spirit of the Lord living amongst us in our chaplaincies. On the final evening, Bishop David Hamid was presented with a leaving gift and he spoke movingly of how blessed he has been during his time of episcopal service in our diocese. The synod next year will take place from 28 – 29 January and it will be online.

We enjoy joining the services at San Pedro when we can and have been made very welcome by the lovely congregation and clergy.

Back in the UK, we used to live in London and then moved to Torquay in Devon about 6 years ago and feel very blessed to enjoy two such beautiful places as Estepona and Torquay. In the past I helped run an advertising agency in London for 30 years and then worked for Church Urban Fund, running their communications and marketing for nearly 7 years before retiring. Marguerite was a chartered accountant and we have 3 grown up children. At home we go to St. Matthias church, which is quite lively and has a congregation of around 100 people.

A verse that is very meaningful to me is Proverbs 3, 5-6 "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him and He will direct your path"

I've also found a great Bible app that helps me on a daily basis which is the YouVersion Bible App, (free on Play Store or Apple equivalent). It has a verse for the day and then a short video of someone explaining it. People range from larger-than-life Americans to the Archbishop of Canterbury, so they always provide a different and interesting perspective to get you thinking.
