#### **LENT COURSE 2024**

## Details were in Pew News dated 28th January - here is a brief reminder.

"The Clewer Initiative, on behalf of the Church of England, has worked with the World Council of Churches to produce a global Lent course to help Christians learn about the challenges of modern slavery and human trafficking. Based upon Paul's letter to the Galatians with its great theme of bondage and freedom, the course offers an opportunity for people to prayerfully consider how best they can make a creative contribution".

### How the course works. Each session consists of the following elements:

- An opening paragraph, sharing the theme of the week and introductory information about modern slavery
- A modern slavery fact file, helping you understand the scale of the issue
- One or two case studies telling the story of a victim of modern slavery some of these have been filmed and can be watched during or after the session
- The bible reading a chapter from Galatians
- A reflection, written by Revd Dr Kenneth Mtata and Bishop Alastair Redfern, drawing on themes from a chapter in the book of Galatians
- A set of questions to encourage discussion and reflection
- An opportunity to look at two contemporary illustrations and consider how they add to your understanding of the theme
- A prayer
- A story of hope
- Some action points

The **San Pedro** course will start on **Thursday 22nd February at 5 pm** and run for 6 weeks, we will have two venues: The homes of Alanna Carter in Nueva Andalucía, for the first one, and Angie Newman in Guadalmina, full addresses will be sent when you let me know you want to go. Each week will stand alone, so it is not essential to attend every week. Details of each weeks programme along with the bible reading will be sent a week in advance. Therefore week one will be attached to this newsletter. Although it would be good to attend a course, for discussion etc. you can, of course, work though the material alone and I hope many swallows in particular will.

In the meantime, to prepare, why not start reading Galatians now.


### **Easter Swallows...**
