### WHAT DO WE DO?

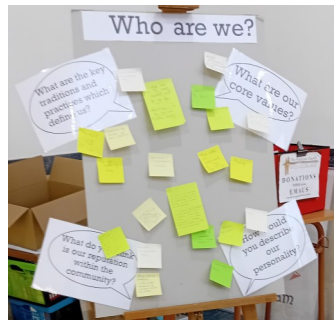
What aspects of our church do we need to preserve?

### HOW DO WE WANT PEOPLE TO FEEL?

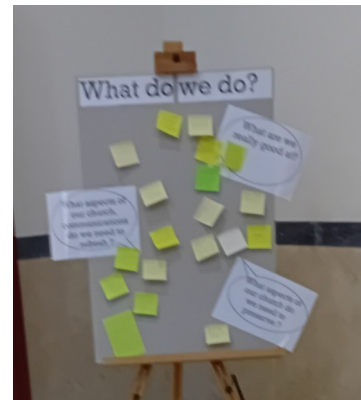
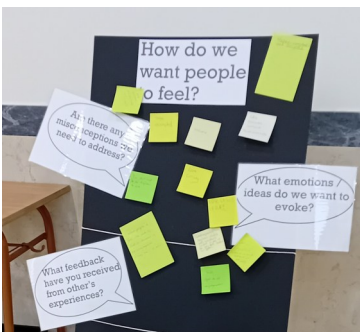
What emotions/ideas do we want to evoke?

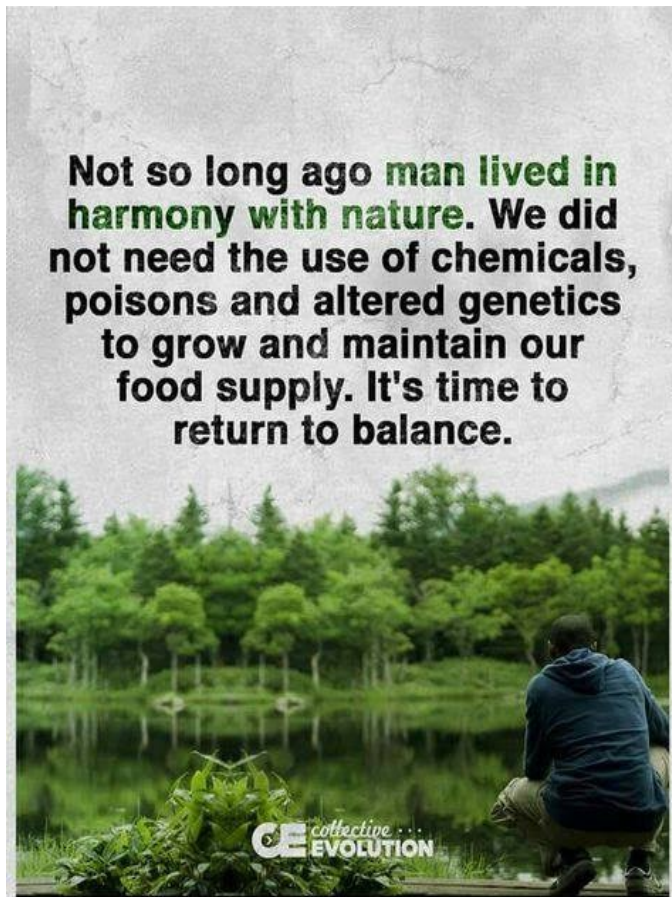

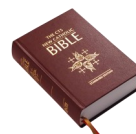

# Vecinos y Amigos Trip to Costa Brava & Barcelona

**13-18th May 2025—6 days, 5 nights**

High Speed Train Malaga to Barcelona (and back!)  
Accommodation in a 4 \* Hotel in Lloret de Mar including breakfast & evening buffet.

The trip also includes: -

- ⇒ Day 1 Travel from Sabinillas on coach & train with lunch on arrival in Barcelona then onto the Hotel to check-in.
- ⇒ Day 2 Walking tour of 3 villages (Cadaques, Empuriabrava & Figueras) with guide & lunch.
- ⇒ Day 3 Walking tour of Barcelona with guide, including entrance to the Cathedral and lunch.
- ⇒ Day 4 Free Day! You can explore Lloret de Mar or take the train or coach back to Barcelona or other nearby sights.
